A Meeting of the Council for the City of Petersburg was held on the above date.

The Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor, James W. Holeman

Stella Kirby who has been cleaning brush at the top of Fernstrom Park, asked if the eastern boundary can be marked. She also asked if the Wastewater plant sign could be moved to the left of the drive and a Fernstrom Park sign put in its place. Mayor Holeman said that could be done.

Moved by Cilley to approve of the Monroe County 100 mile bike path that will go through the City of Petersburg and the accompanying proposed signage to be installed. Supported by Richards. Aye (7) Nay (0) Absent (0) Motion carried.

Richards will look into the possibility of a bike repair station.

Mayor reported restoration work from the water project has begun and should be complete this week.
